

LAMBTON KENT SOCCER ASSOCIATION TEAM OFFICIALS REQUIREMENTS

Lambton Kent Soccer Association requires all coaches and assistant coaches of competitive teams to be fully qualified as specified in the Ontario Soccer Operational Procedures Section 11, Procedure 3.0. Grassroots coaches are nominally volunteers and where practical are encouraged by the District to obtain the NCCP Coaching Certification for the appropriate age group. All clubs will have Team Officials screened in accordance with Ontario Soccer Risk Management Screening Hand Book

The levels of coaching are based on the age of the players coached:

Age Group	NCCP Coach Courses
4-6 year olds	Active Start
6-9 year olds	<u>Fundamentals</u>
9-12 year olds	Learn to Train
13+ year olds	Soccer for Life

In addition, the pre requisite for each course includes the following:

- 1. Respect in Sport for Activity Leader,
- 2. Make Ethical Decision [both Practical & Evaluation],
- 3. Making Head Way in Soccer, and
- 4. NCCP Emergency Action Plan.

Managers and Assistant Managers in order to be registered to the club team and sit on the bench are required to complete the following courses:

- 1. Respect in Sport for Activity Leader, and
- 2. Make Ethical Decision [both Practical & Evaluation]
